- (2) Location: Xianglin Giant Tree Platform, Alishan National Forest Recreation Area
- (3) Participant Limit: 15 couples from Taiwan or abroad (plus 3 alternates). To qualify as an overseas couple, at least one partner must be a non-Taiwanese national
- (4) Registration Period:
 - Opens: Friday, May 20, 2025, at 12:00 noon
 - Closes: Friday, June 20, 2025, at 11:59 PM
 - Registration is considered complete upon verification of the submitted information.

- The final list of selected couples will be announced on Monday, June 30, 2025, at 12:00 noon on the official website of the Alishan National Scenic Area Headquarters.
- (5) Registration Method: Online registration. The registration link will be available on both the Alishan National Scenic Area Headquarters official website and the Alishan New Impressions Facebook page.

(10) Refund policy:

If a selected couple has completed payment at least one month before the event but is unable to attend due to extenuating circumstances (such as a family emergency or urgent surgery), they must notify the organizer and provide supporting documentation no later than the day before the event to receive a full refund. Refund requests on the event day will not be accepted.

1. Cancellation Policy

In accordance with the amended announcement (No. 1050922838) by the Taiwan Tourism Administration regarding domestic tourism contracts:

- If a couple fails to attend the event without prior notice, they forfeit 100% of the fee.
- If cancellation occurs one day before the event, 50% of the fee will be forfeited.
- If cancellation occurs 2 to 20 days before the event, 30% of the fee will be forfeited.
- If the day before the event falls on a weekend or national holiday, the last working day before the event will be considered as the deadline for the one-day cancellation policy.
- 2. Substitutes or proxies are **not allowed** to attend in place of registered participants at any time during the event.

5. Proxies are not allowed.
