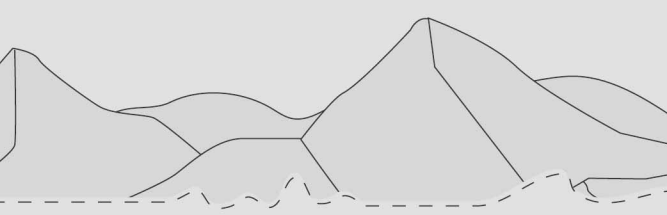





This helps infuse the beans with a strong sweetness. During the Japanese colonial period, this area was dominated by the harvesting of cypress trees and the planting of tea. Thus, the coffees produced here exude the refreshing flavors of Taiwan's unique high-quality teas, such as lemon black tea, as well as cypress.
